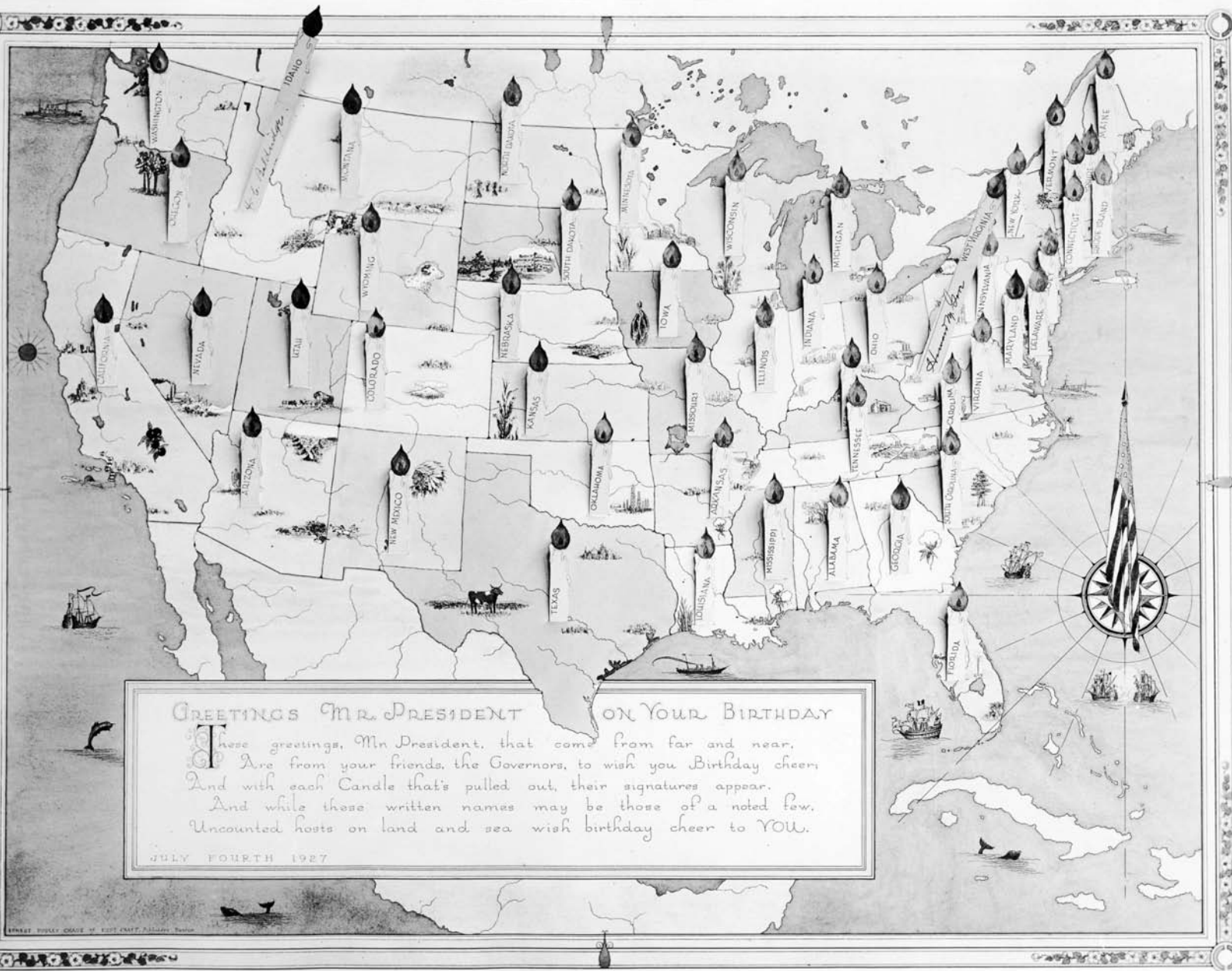
This does not show the color but will give you an idea of the drawing and general composition, together with the sentiment.
