Dear Sir:

I am hereby presenting my claim in my cooperation in the capture of Charles A. "Pretty Boy" Floyd who was shot Oct. 22nd 1934 by Department of Justice men led by Melvin Purvis.

"Pretty Boy" came to our home Mon. Oct. 22. about 11:45 asked to wash and ^{for} a sandwich, which was given him.

I reported at once to an officer in about 35 min. the Department of Justice men were here, he had entered an wooden area and was driven through it and came out on the opposite side when seen he was commanded to halt. As he did not they fired and killed him.

I understand there was Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000) offered by your state, also One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.) added by Lieut Gov. Robt. Burns, acting

as state executive, in the absence of Gov.
Bill Murray after a conference of peace
officers early in 1932. For which
I am entitled to.
